Dear Neighbors,

On Tuesday, November 5, Lakeshore residents will vote on the continuation of a parcel fee to provide security for East and West Lakeshore. A YES vote will ensure the patrol will operate for four more years with 24 hour coverage of our neighborhood. Without it, there will be no patrol.

While costs are rising, the parcel fee of 420.00 will remain the same as it has been for the last four years. All monies are used for the patrol /security.

There is no doubt that the patrol has been paramount in making Lakeshore one of the safest neighborhoods in the city. The guards are trained, armed and dedicated to our community. The Pinnacle truck is present 24 hours, 7 days a week and may be reached by calling the dedicated cell number, 504-439-1206.

In the past three months, Pinnacle reported making 1,181 drive-bys, responding to 20 calls from residents, checking 10 houses for out of town residents, conducting 11 escorts and addressing 5 suspicious persons. Please continue to call the guards if you see anything suspicious. You have been doing this and it is a great help.

As always, you are reminded to be aware of your surroundings and careful of being followed. Keep your vehicles locked. Remove all valuables, including and especially guns. Keep your property well lit as the police have stated this is a great deterrent to crime. Thank you.

Please look out for one another. It is imperative that we do all possible to promote a good quality of life for those in our community and safety is paramount to that quality. Please also follow the speed limits and obey the stop signs.

We hope that all residents will vote YES to maintain the 24 hour patrol. The Lakeshore Crime Commission District exists solely to help protect our residents and property.

The next meeting will be held Wednesday, September 11 at Mt. Carmel at 6:30 p.m. Signs will be posted and all are invited.
