Dear Neighbors,

On Tuesday, November 3, Lakeshore residents will vote on the continuation of a parcel fee to provide security for East and West Lakeshore. A YES vote will ensure the patrol will operate for four more years with 24 hour plus coverage of our neighborhood. Without it, there will be no patrol.

The parcel fee of 420.00 is a slight increase from the 360.00 that has stayed the same for fifteen years. Costs obviously have been rising and the increase is necessary to maintain 24 hour coverage. All monies are used for the patrol/security.

There is no doubt that the patrol has been paramount in making Lakeshore one of the safest, if not the safest, neighborhood in the city, helping to avert crime before it occurs. Beginning in January, 2021, the Lakeshore Crime Prevention Board has budgeted for the 24 hour coverage and an added car with 10 more hours of patrolling.

Pinnacle reported that in their first 30 days, guards completed 177 drive-by resident contacts, responded to four alarms and addressed suspicious persons. There was one incident last month of car break-ins but no other reported crime.

Besides conducting drive-bys, Pinnacle stated that officers will periodically position the security vehicle at access points into the neighborhood to maximize visibility of those entering the community. The company also reported that their use of flashing lights on patrol cars is a proven deterrent to crime.

Pinnacle provides guard service escort from your vehicle to your home. Residents should contact the security patrol at the assigned cell number, 439-1206. Please also call this number to report any suspicious persons or incidents.

We hope that all residents vote YES to maintain the 24 hour patrol of East and West Lakeshore. The Lakeshore Crime Prevention District Board exists solely to help protect our residents and property.

As always, you are reminded to be aware of your surroundings. Be careful of being followed now and as we move into the holiday season. Remove all valuables from your vehicles and please keep them locked.

Labels are included in this mailing for your use with the patrol cell number.

The next meeting will be held Wednesday, November 4 at Mt. Carmel at 6:30 p.m. Signs will be posted and all are invited.
