1) **Call to order**

Byron Casey called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Mr. Casey confirmed the attendance of all commissioners listed above and that a quorum existed. Mr. Casey further confirmed that the public had been notified of the meeting in accordance with Louisiana's Open Meeting Laws.

2) **Minutes From Prior Meeting:**

A motion was made by Byron Casey to waive the reading and accept the minutes for the meeting of March 9, 2022. James Grevemberg seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion was unanimously approved.

3) **Report Of Pinnacle Security**

Chad Perez of Pinnacle Security presented the crime briefing and introduced Scott Monistere as the branch manager for Lakeshore. Mr. Perez advised that there were 46 Resident Calls for the July – August time period as well as 138 Escorts. There were also 43 Residential Checks and 4 Residential Alarm. Mr. Perez also reported that there were 20 Suspicious Persons observed during the time period.

Mr. Casey then opened a virtual presentation by Flock Safety of Atlanta for surveillance cameras. Flock advised that Lake Vista had these cameras installed. Mr. Casey stated he would contact the President of Lake Vista Crime Board to see how they liked the system.
