### Minutes of the Meeting of the Board of Commissioners On September 2 , 2015

A meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Lakeshore Crime Prevention District was held at 6:30 PM on Wednesday, September 2, 2015 at Mt. Carmel Academy, 7027 Milne Boulevard, New Orleans, Louisiana 70124. All participants attended in person.

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1) **Call to order**

Byron Casey called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Mr. Casey confirmed the attendance of all commissioners listed above and that a quorum existed. Mr. Casey further confirmed that the public had been notified of the meeting in accordance with Louisiana's Open Meeting Laws.

2) **Minutes From Prior Meeting:**

A motion was made by Jacque Touzet to waive the reading and accept the minutes for the meetings of July 8, 2015. Byron Casey seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion was unanimously approved.

3) **Report Of Metro Security**

Nancy (?) of Metro reviewed the incident reports from July and August 2015 and provided handouts of the reports to all in attendance. Nancy reported in July and August that there had been reports of various Suspicious Persons. Metro performed 601 drive by escorts during the 2 month period as well as 17 dispatched escorts. Metro investigated 29 suspicious persons and vehicles and responded

to 13 alarms during these two months. Metro also provided 16 residential checks for the 2 month period as well as 12 unsecured property checks.

Upon completion of Metro Security's report, Byron Casey announced the next meeting would be on November 4 at 6:30 p.m.

4) **LCPD Alumni Comments**

Ray Kleinpeter expressed the neighbors' thanks for the job the board is doing and for a quiet neighborhood.

5) **Board Members Business Reports & Feedback**

Susan Simon: Susan Simon presented the Revenue and Expenditures as of August 31, 2015 (attached) and stating that 99.67% of funds had been collected.

Byron Casey: Byron Casey updated the status regarding the Crime Cameras implementation in that there were 4-5 cameras left to install in East Lakeshore and 2-3 cameras left to install in West Lakeshore.

Mr. Casey opened discussion regarding the posting of the Metro Reports on the website. After lengthy discussion wherein the pros and cons of posting the reports on the website it was decided that they would be available on request by calling Mr. Casey at 504-259-8438. The motion was passed unanimously.

6) **Adjournment:**

After confirming that there was no additional business meeting Byron Casey moved and Jacque Tauzet seconded to adjourn the meeting at 7:15P.M. The next meeting is to be held November 4, 2015 at Mount Carmel Academy.
