Dear Neighbors,

As a reminder, on Tuesday, November 5, Lakeshore residents will vote on the continuation of a parcel fee to provide security for East and West Lakeshore. A YES vote will ensure the patrol will operate for four more years. Without it, there will be no patrol.

While costs are rising, the parcel fee of 420.00 will remain as it has been for the last four years with all monies devoted to the patrol/security.

The patrol has helped make Lakeshore one of the safest neighborhoods in the city. The guards are trained, armed and dedicated to our community. The Pinnacle truck is present 24 hours, 7 days a week and may be reached by calling the dedicated cell number, 504-439-1206.

Pinnacle provides statistics for our neighborhood every two months. In the last two months, there has been no reported crime!! Guards have responded to alarms, checked houses for out of town residents and conducted escorts. Please call the guard if you would like him to be present as you exit your vehicle to enter your home.

There have been 25 calls from residents to the company or directly to the guards, including calls to report suspicious activity. Your calls are appreciated.

Please keep your vehicles locked. Remove all valuables, including and especially, guns. Always be aware of your surroundings, especially when entering or exiting your vehicle.

You are reminded to follow the speed limits and stop at stop signs. Speeding has become an escalating problem, especially on Canal Blvd. and General Haig. Obeying the speed limits is necessary for everyone's safety, especially the children. Thank you for your cooperation.

Please continue to look out for one another as we strive to promote a safe, positive and fulfilling environment for our community. We hope that all residents will vote YES to maintain our 24 hour patrol. The Lakeshore Crime Commission exists solely to help protect our residents and property.

The next meeting will be held on Wednesday, November 6 at Mt. Carmel at 6:30 p.m. Signs will be posted and all are invited.

We would also like to remind you that Lakeshore Property Owners Association will have a General Meeting/Wine Social at Robert's Fresh Market's meeting room on the second floor at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, November 4.
