### Minutes of the Meeting of the Board of Commissioners On January 7, 2015

A meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Lakeshore Crime Prevention District was held at 6:30 PM on Wednesday, January 7, 2015 at Mt. Carmel Academy, 7027 Milne Boulevard, New Orleans, Louisiana 70124. All participants attended in person.

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1) **Call to order**

Byron Casey called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Mr. Casey confirmed the attendance of all commissioners listed above and that a quorum existed. Mr. Casey further confirmed that the public had been notified of the meeting in accordance with Louisiana's Open Meeting Laws.

2) **Minutes From Prior Meeting:**

A motion was made by Susan Simon to waive the reading and accept the minutes for the meetings of November 5, 2014. James Grevemberg seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion was unanimously approved.

3) **Report Of Metro Security**

Lloyd Jarreau of Metro reviewed the incident reports from November and December 2014 and provided handouts of the reports to all in attendance. Mr. Jarreau reported that Metro had a possible suspect car that had been used in auto break-ins around the neighborhood. The car, spotted by Metro Security Officers, was a Toyota Corolla, with license WRZ318 if anyone spotted it they should call Metro. Mr. Jarreau reported in November and December that there had been reports of various Suspicious

Persons. Metro performed 322 drive by escorts during the 2 month period as well as 4 dispatched escorts. Metro investigated 16 suspicious persons and vehicles and responded to 6 alarms during these two months. Metro also provided 14 residential checks for the 2 month period. It was further reported by Mr. Jarreau that there had been several cars burglarized during the previous months due to unlocked doors – please remember to remove items and lock your car!

Upon completion of Metro Security's report, Byron Casey announced the next meeting would be on March 4 at 6:30 p.m.

4) **LCPD Alumni Comments**

Ray Kleinpeter congratulated the LCPD Board on the overall good results and good financial condition the board had achieved in the past 12 months.

5) **Board Members Business Reports & Feedback**

Susan Simon: Susan presented the Revenue and Expenditures as of December, 2014 – January 2015 (attached). She further advised that the audit charges were not to exceed \$2,800 and that the budget came in with a small surplus.

Byron Casey: Byron advised he had several discussions with Mr. Causey regarding seeing guards texting or sleeping on their post as a result 4 guards had their jobs terminated. Byron also discussed the resident at 800 Amethyst, Ms. Von Voorhies who is illegally renting her house for short term leases, he had several conversations advising her that she was violating the law she said her leases were long term.

Byron also advised that as of January 7 West Lakeshore needed four more houses to host crime cameras and only one more house was needed in East Lakeshore.

Guest comments: Patrick Levy noted that there were stakes adjacent to the levee at General Haig and Turquoise - Byron advised that was for electrical service for the new Orleans Canal Pump.

6) **Adjournment:**

After confirming that there was no additional business meeting Susan Simon moved and Bonnie Nelson seconded to adjourn the meeting at 7:25P.M. The next meeting is to be held March 4, 2015 at Mount Carmel Academy.
